Karaoke Rules and Etiquette

- Please turn in one request slip at a time. When you **SING ONE, BRING ONE**. Everyone will sing in the order in which their requests are received. Duets will count as one turn for each singer.
- New singers will have priority their first time up; they will be mixed in with the old singers - one old, one new. Once a new singer sings they will have to wait their turn just like everyone else.
- At times a rotation may get a little long - **PLEASE BE PATIENT**. No amount of begging, tipping, threatening or flattery will get you move up in line. Relax and have a good time.
- Any singer who turns in a request under a different name, in order to defeat the rotation, will not sing for the remainder of the night. Be fair.
- Do not boo, harass, heckle or interrupt a singer. Please applaud every singer after every performance. Getting up to sing in front of people can be very intimidating if the crowd isn't encouraging. Treat others as you would have them treat you.
- Please leave your drinks and smokes at your table. The equipment is expensive and does not like wetness and fire.
- Don't swing the microphones by the cord or drop them. Please be respectful of my equipment. "You break it, you buy it."
- Do not use foul language over the microphone.
- You do not have to sing well to sing karaoke. This is not Amateur Night at the Apollo.
- **You should sing - IT'S FUN!** If you are a first timer and feel too nervous to get up...don't worry about it. We're all here tonight to just have a good time.
